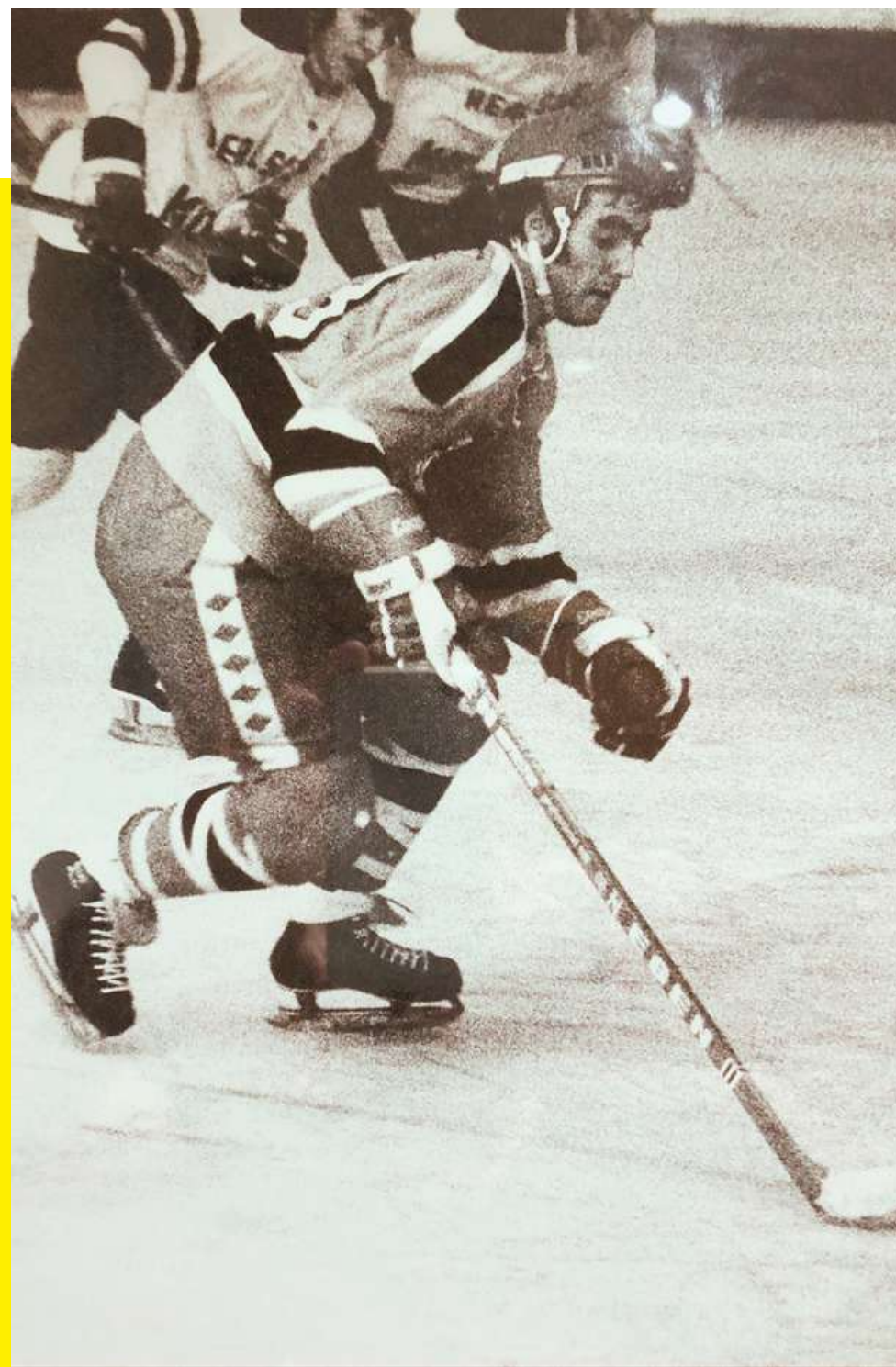

AS A PLAYER

- Played in **Toronto 1970's, Canada MTHL Juvenile, Preston Raiders Jr B OHL**
- Played at the **1970 TSSAA Ontario Final**
- Played for FC Barcelona, CH Casco Viejo & CG Puigcerda during 15 seasons in the **Spanish National Hockey League** and won several Leagues & Cups with all three Clubs and retired as a player in 1986
- Played at **IIHF European Cup & Continental Cup**
- Participated at **9 IIHF World Championships** as Captain in 40 games achieving 41 points (21 Goals & 20 Assists); including the first historical National Spanish Team at the 1977 IIHF World Championship in Copenhagen



AS A GAME OFFICIAL

- Started Game Officiating in 1987 as a **Linesman & Referee**
- Became **Referee-in-Chief** in 1992 until 2002
- Officiated in **12 IIHF World Championships, 2 FISU University Games**
- Translated the **IIHF Rulebook** into Spanish
